Minutes The Minutes of the previous meeting, having been circulated were confirmed as a correct record.

Reports **Shropshire Councillor** Cllr Tindall said that he had not been able to obtain a definitive reply regarding future Lengthsman's funding but would make further enquiries.
Mr.Smith described the continuing drainage problems in the Oldfield Lane and asked if Cllr.Tindall could enquire when a second gully could be inserted in order to prevent the flow of water onto the lane.

Highways The white junction markings at Southall Paddocks drive had still not yet been completed although the Parish Council had paid £97.83 towards the cost. The clerk was instructed to write and ask for a refund if the work was not to be carried out immediately. The amount would be re-paid on completion.
