Minutes Following an amendment i.e. Cllr.Tindall said that 'Parish Councils with a precept of less than £500,000' not £100,000 would not be capped. The Minutes of the previous meeting, having been circulated were confirmed as a correct record.

Reports Shropshire Councillor Cllr.Tindall reported that applications for shotgun licences would be speeded up.
S.Council would in future invest in underused premises to promote more facilities, which could then be let to bring in an income for the Council
